These species include the Arabian Horse Mackerel (*Trachurus indicus*) and a local Mackerel species (*Scomber japonicus*), both of which are predominantly found within the coastal shelf of Oman's Arabian Sea area.

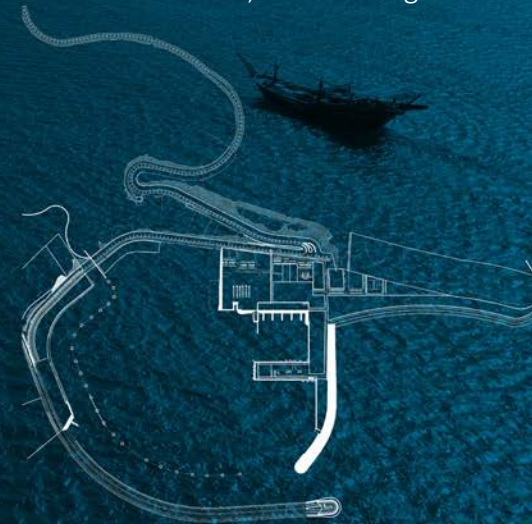

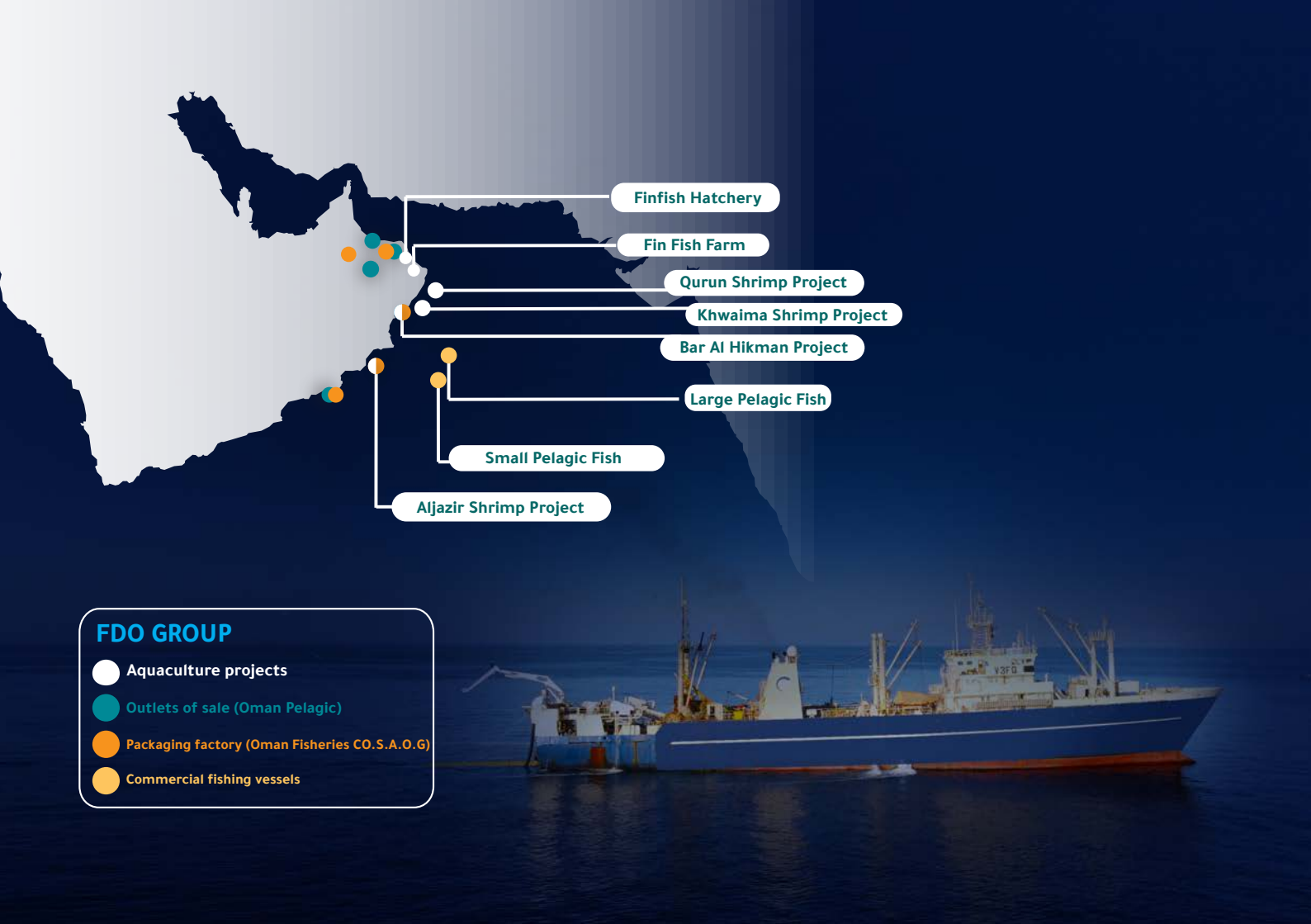
